London Baroque performs regularly throughout Europe and has appeared at the London Early Music Centre, Flanders, Holland, Gottingen, Bath, Innsbruck, Turku, Stour and Swedish Baroque Festivals and broadcast for the BBC, West, North and South German Radio, Bavarian, Austrian, Dutch, Belgian, Swiss, Italian, Finnish, Danish, Norwegian and French Radio, with television appearances in Germany, Austria and Sweden.

In April London Baroque made a successful debut tour of the United States and later this year, London Baroque tours to France, Austria, Germany and Poland and next year goes to Japan and Eastern Europe.


