NEW EXAMINATIONS FOR ORGANISTS



For over 100 years the Associated Board has been providing a valuable service to music education.

Each year more than half a million candidates are examined in recognised graded standards of musical performance and theory.

For organists, the syllabuses have recently been extended and in addition to Grades 4 - 8 now include:

An examination which offers candidates the choice of performing on manuals only.

Advanced Certificate

A post-Grade 8 qualification which can be used as an intermediate step leading to the diplomas of the Royal Schools of Music or as preparation for a course at a higher education level.

LRSM

The LRSM is equivalent in standard to the diploma of LRAM or ARCM conferred in the United Kingdom by the Royal Academy and Royal College separately, and is entitled to receive equal recognition.

The syllabus for 1992 and onwards has been extensively revised and reflects the need for all future diploma holders of the Royal Schools of Music to have a broad base of musicianship whatever their chosen specialism.

Part 1 of the syllabus is common to all candidates and may be taken either by written examination or by approved course-work assessment.

Candidates may then elect to take one of the following Branches:

- A: Composition
- B: Music for the School Curriculum
- C: Teaching
- D: Performance
- E: Direction (Bandmastership, Choral or Orchestral Conducting)
- F: Piano Accompaniment
