

Entrance is by competitive audition; many scholarships and exhibitions are awarded each year. Full details of all courses and facilities, including special one-year courses for organists planning to continue to University, are contained in the Prospectus and Entrance Guide, obtainable on application to the College. The ARCM teaching and performing diploma examinations are open to external applicants and syllabuses may be obtained on application.
