

FEES - BURSARIES - CLOSING DATE

Summer School Fee - £320

This inclusive fee covers tuition, accommodation and meals, travel costs during the week and attendance at all concerts and events offered by Oundle International Festival from mid-day Sunday 17 July to mid-day Sunday 24 July. Students live in Oundle School houses and can use the school's recreational facilities. Meals are taken in a house dining room and at the Festival Club, the hub of the week's activities.

Bursaries

Through the generosity of The Carnegie United Kingdom Trust, the Douglas May Bequest and others, the Summer School for Young Organists is able to offer partial (or full) bursaries to students who have need for financial assistance. It is our expectation that up to 50% of our applicants in 1994 may be eligible for such aid. If you wish to apply, please submit a brief letter stating your case with your application form.

Observers - £125 weekly or £25 daily

The fee includes attendance at lectures and master classes and all concerts and events at Oundle International Festival, as well as lunches and evening meals with the students. Observers must arrange their own bed and breakfast accommodation. We will be happy to provide a list of recommended guest houses and hotels.

Closing Date

Applications from students must be submitted not later than 1 April 1994. Observers may apply later on a space-available basis; please enquire!

Payment Dates

DO NOT SEND ANY MONEY WITH YOUR APPLICATION. Successful applicants will be notified on or about 30 April 1994 and requested to make an immediate payment of £100 to hold a place; the balance of fees is payable no later than 8 July 1994.
