He has also performed in many cathedrals and concert halls in Britain and throughout Europe, the US and Canada, in addition to broadcasting and recording.

Now as Dean, he continues to support the Master of the Music at the Cathedral in the




development of the great tradition of Cathedral music. His preaching and training take him throughout the Diocese and to a number of other countries. A collection will be made during the service.


