Students will live at Fletton House, Oundle, which is furnished and equipped to a very comfortable standard. Pastoral supervision by experienced staff will be a central feature. Besides the organ classes and excursion to Cambridge, there will be leisure activities and time to relax.

Where is Oundle?

Oundle is an attractive historic country town on the A605, fourteen miles west of Peterborough.

Access by road is now very easy; the A14, which links A1 and M1, passes just 8 miles to the south of Oundle. By train, Peterborough is on the main line from London King's Cross to Edinburgh; we will meet trains if necessary.

How much?

The all-inclusive fee for students attending
Pulling Out The Stops will be £80.

Welcome will be on Friday 14 February between 11 and 11.30am and the course will end with an informal concert, given by the students, in Oundle School Chapel on Sunday 16 February at 2.30pm. Parents and friends are warmly invited to attend this event.

How do I apply?

Complete the application form and send by 15 December 1996. Please enclose a letter from your teacher giving us some information about your musical background, interests and accomplishments. Send no money with your application.

When we receive your application we will suggest some organ pieces that we should like you to try out before coming to Oundle.

By 10 January 1997 we shall let you know whether we can offer you a place on the course.
Full joining instructions will be sent at that time.

The national press has highlighted the shortage of organists which exists in some places. On the other hand, the allure of the organ remains as potent as ever for those young people who are fortunate enough to hear a good instrument well played. The Royal College of Organists is delighted that this intensive course for beginners is being started in so suitable a place as Oundle, and wishes every success to both students and teachers.
