All three have starred in the Fats Waller musical, *Ain't Misbehaving* in London in 1995.

Debby Bishop has a long list of credits to her name in theatre, television and radio. She has starred on television with such names as Lenny Henry, Jasper Carrot and Billy Connolly, and has received Personality of the Year Award several times, for her part as Bella in LWT's hit series *Widows*, and also for *Les Girls*, *Pirates* and *The Bill*. Debby has also worked with various recording artists, including Freddie Mercury and Spandau Ballet.

Dawn Hope made her West End debut at sixteen, appearing in several musicals and co-starring with Cliff Richard in *Time*. She has twice played the role of Josephine Baker: in *Josephine* and also in Sir Peter Hall's production of *Piaf*. Dawn has appeared in many film and television roles, including *General Hospital*, *Angels*, *Dempsey and Makepeace*, and most recently in *The Heart Surgeon*.

Melanie E Marshall studied singing and piano at the Royal College of Music, winning prizes in singing and languages. Her career encompasses many styles of music, from jazz to musical theatre, oratorio to opera. She has performed with many prominent theatre and opera companies including the RSC/Opera North production of *Showboat* and *Porgy and Bess* with Glyndebourne Festival Opera. Melanie has also recorded two jazz albums, one of which was made with her brother, pianist and organist Wayne Marshall, with whom she last appeared at the Oundle Festival in 1991.
