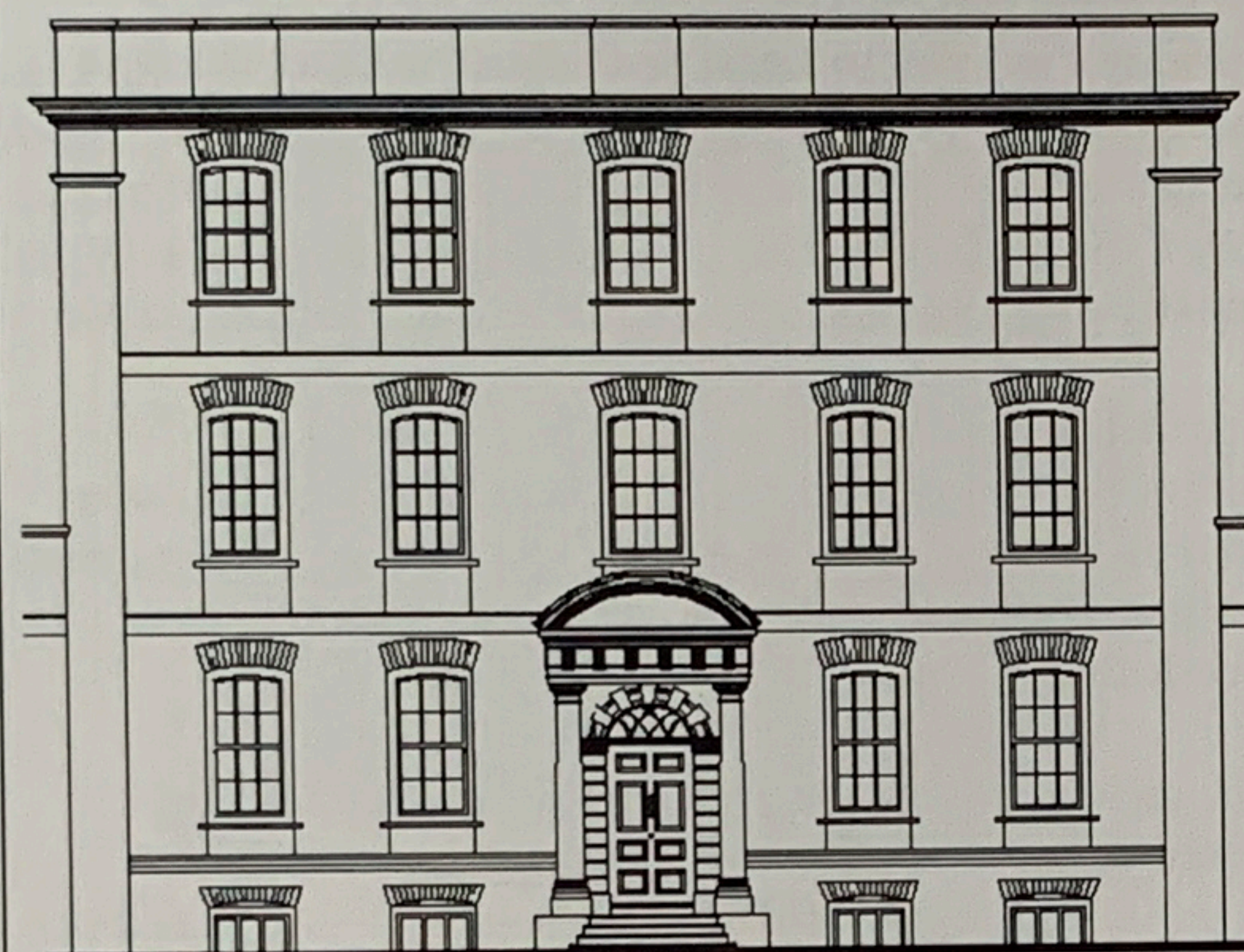

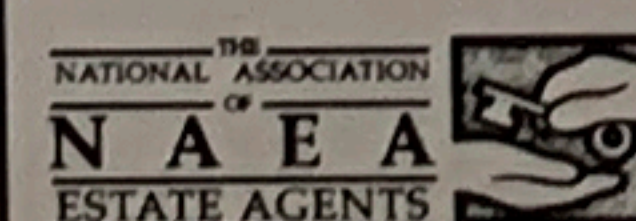

In 1996 **London Community Gospel Choir** made its first visit to Oundle, giving an electric performance in a packed Oundle School Chapel, and bringing the audience to its feet with its rich gospel sound. The choir has worked with artists such as Tina Turner, Diana Ross, Sir Elton John, Sting and Sir Paul McCartney, in live appearances and studio recordings. Highlights in the career of LCGC include participation in the soundtrack for Walt Disney's film *The Lion King*, performing for Nelson Mandela during his famous visit to London in 1996, and singing at Spice Girl Mel B's wedding in 1998. They make many recordings, and have toured extensively around the world.

Victor Hugo and La Banda Picante have also performed for many celebrities throughout Europe and beyond, including members of the British Royal family, Mick Jagger, Joan Collins and Claudia Schiffer. Mixing authentic salsa with the rapid rhythms of Rap, Merengue, Cumbia and Afro-Cuban jazz, Victor Hugo produces his own distinctive style. Accompanied by musicians from Venezuela, Cuba, Puerto Rico and Colombia, the superb dancers will take us on an extraordinary journey through the heart and soul of Latin America.
