Oundle's new Museum, opened in 2000, has a special exhibition for this first year of the new Millennium, on the theme of Time.

The movement of the earth around the sun controls the seasons of the year, and night and day depend upon the rotation of the earth. On display in Oundle Museum's Time exhibition is a clockwork model of the solar system, an orrery, made c. 1900. Also shown are calendars of different religions and cultures, and the methods by which objects of great antiquity can be dated. Part of the exhibition concentrates upon the skill of watch and clock makers, including examples of watches made by an Oundle craftsman.
