## Guided tour Visit to 78 Derngate, Northampton

*House designed by  
Charles Rennie Mackintosh*

This tiny house in the centre of Northampton was Charles Rennie Mackintosh's last commission, designed in 1916/17 for one of England's greatest model train makers: W J Bassett-Lowke and his wife. No 78 has been painstakingly restored to capture its 1917 appearance and stunning art nouveau décor, with fascinating attention to detail.

In the adjoining property are exhibitions exploring the lives and work of Mackintosh and Bassett-Lowke, together with some of Bassett-Lowke's exquisite model collection.
