

French Film Season NOTRE MUSIQUE (12A)

Director: Jean-Luc Godard (2004)



Part poetry, part journalism, part philosophy, Jean-Luc Godard's 'Notre Musique[is a timeless meditation on war as seen through the prisms of cinema, text and image. Largely set at a literary conference in Sarajevo, the film draws on the conflagration of the Bosnian war, but also draws on the Israeli/Palestinian conflict, the brutal treatment of Native Americans, and the legacy of the Nazis.

Structured into three Dantean Kingdoms - Hell, Purgatory and Heaven - the film intermingles real-life literary figures (including Arab poet Mahmoud Darwish and Spanish writer Juan Goytisolo) with actors; documentary meshes with fiction.

Candidates are invited to apply for the Organ Scholarship at Dulwich College. The value of the Scholarship is up to 30% of tuition fees. This Scholarship may be supplemented by a means tested bursary if there is genuine financial need. The Scholarship also provides free tuition on Organ and a second instrument or voice. Applicants are required to meet the academic requirements of the College. Candidates should be Grade 7/8 standard.

There are two Organs used by the College. The Organ in Christ's Chapel of God's Gift, Dulwich is due for complete restoration in 2006/7.

The past two Organ Scholars have won Organ Scholarships to Gonville & Caius College and Trinity Hall College, Cambridge.
