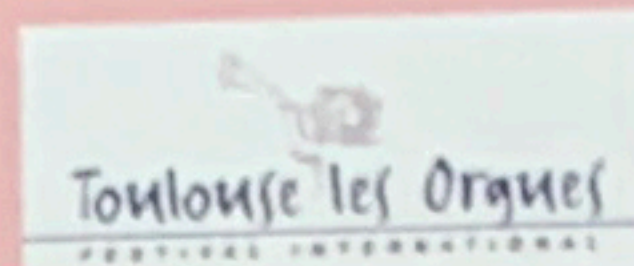


Oundle for Organists in Toulouse

Toulouse is a paradise for organists and home to the established October *Toulouse les Orgues* Festival. Key organs include Cavaillé-Coll's celebrated 1889 instrument in Basilique St Sernin, and the stunning modern 'baroque' organ by Ahrend in Église-musée des Augustins. In October 2006, twelve Oundle for Organists students enjoyed our pilot 'hands-on' week in Toulouse, and we are offering this inspirational experience to twelve more in October 2007.
