
Royal Holloway offers excellent opportunities for singers and organists to work with one of the country's finest mixed-voice collegiate choirs.

Tonbridge awards over 70 music scholarships. Choral Boarding Places worth 10% of the school fee are also available without examination for choristers of Cathedrals and Collegiate Choir schools.

Scholarships are awarded of 10% of the value of the school fee, plus free music tuition. All scholarships will be supplemented up to 100% of the full fee according to financial need.

Three orchestras, two bands, a large choral society and chamber ensembles provide wide opportunities for high quality music making, both within and beyond the school. The cathedral-standard Chapel Choir maintains an exceptional choral tradition; the magnificent rebuilt Chapel contains an outstanding 4-manual Marcussen organ.

More than half the school receive musical instrument tuition from 8 full-time and 40 visiting staff. Music award winners are given extra practice time within the curriculum.

The Director of Music, Mark Forkgen, is always happy to meet informally with parents and their sons in advance of the scholarship auditions, held in late January.
